Using traditional instrumentation like Jaranas and Tarimas (a wooden platform) from Son Jarocho (Mexico), Primero from Garifuna (Belize), Djembe from West Africa, Accordions and Tambora from Colombia, and many more, El Santo Golpe uses their music as a universal language to help close gaps between different cultures, genres, ages and believes, creating a world community where we call can dance, sing, laugh and forget about our daily troubles.
